Thank you for your interest in the Monarch Dinner Program. Our students look forward to this weekly tradition and the warm nutritious dinners that they share with their families. Dinners at Monarch are served every Monday and Friday night at 5:00pm. As a volunteer group, you sign up to bring food, prepare it, serve it, and clean up. Please prepare for 80 people. Our kitchen is yours as early as 3:00pm. You're welcome to use all of our pots, pans, and serving ware. We also have paper and plastic utensils, plates, and cups that are available for you to use too. Dinner, which includes a main dish, some kind of vegetable, drinks, and dessert, is set up buffet style in our courtyard. The menu is up to you. We have 3 banquet tables you can use and table cloths. Groups usually send between 5-10 people to help.
